## TUITION FEES

The maximum amount of fees for a full-time enrollment at one of our courses in a.y. 2021/2022 is of € 1.600,00 which includes € 140.00 for the regional tax for the right to study and the € 16.00 for the tax stamp.

International students are supposed to pay fees based on their origin countries :

- Students coming from particularly poor countries pay 156 euros per year
- Students coming from non-OECD member countries pay 156 euros per year
- Students coming from OECD member countries pay 387 euros per year
