Today, UniMC stands as an esteemed institution with a rich history and a strong commitment to academic excellence. Unique in Italy, UniMC is a university entirely dedicated to the social sciences and the humanities, offering degree courses that span from law to education, from political science to the languages, literature, and philosophy, from cultural heritage to economics, from communication science and linguistics to tourism.

**We offer seven degree courses entirely taught in English:**

- 1 bachelor’s degree programme
- 3 master’s degree programmes
- 3 double/multiple master’s degree programmes

**And thirty-one degree courses taught in Italian:**

- 13 three-year bachelor’s degree courses
- 2 single-cycle master’s degree courses
- 13 two-year master’s degree courses
- 3 double master’s degree courses

Since the Middle Ages, when the wandering clerics travelled from one place of study to another, and down through the centuries, the **University of Macerata (UniMC)** has been a pivotal centre of learning. Situated in the beautiful Marche region in Central Italy (just three hours from Rome), the University of Macerata is known for the quality of its teaching and research and for its focus on the humanities and the social sciences.

As one of the world’s oldest universities, UniMC has woven a dense network of international relations. Today, this worldwide network offers many valuable opportunities to our students to enjoy unique learning experiences and exposure to different teaching methods from all around the world and in particular from across Europe where we have more than 200 partner universities as

part of the European Union's Erasmus+ programme, and also in North and South America, Asia, Australia, and Africa, thanks to the scholarships funded by our overseas programme.

The University of Macerata is a member of **ERUA (European Reform University Alliance)**, a transnational European University group supported by the European Commission that brings together universities located in nine countries (Bulgaria, Denmark, France, Germany, Greece, Italy, Lithuania, Poland, Spain) specialising, like Macerata, in the social sciences and the humanities. ERUA aims to lead the way towards the universities of the future, promoting European values and identity, and revolutionising the quality of European higher education through a ground-breaking cooperation model.

### DOUBLE OR MULTIPLE DEGREE COURSES

Double or multiple degree programmes consist of an integrated study path created through international agreements with foreign Universities. Eligible students attend part of their studies at the partner University. These programmes allow students to obtain an Italian degree and one or more foreign degree(s). Admission to a double or multiple degree programme is granted on a competitive basis and is achieved through the procedures described in specific calls for application launched by Departments yearly.

# ENROL AT UNIMC

UniMC offers a wide range of degree programmes in the fields of social sciences and the humanities. In Italy, to be eligible for bachelor's level studies, you must hold a secondary school qualification issued after a minimum of 12 years of schooling; for master's level studies, you must hold a bachelor's degree or equivalent foreign qualification with specific curricular requirements awarded by an accredited higher education institution, enabling to proceed to the subsequent level of education in the country where it was issued.

## ADMISSION PROCEDURE

### Online pre-admission application

If you hold an international diploma and are applying for a bachelor's or master's degree programme at UNIMC, you can follow an online pre-evaluation procedure. ### Pre-enrolment through the Italian Consulate/Embassy

In the Spring, and following the deadline set by the Italian Ministry of University and Research, non-EU citizens living outside Italy must submit the pre-enrolment application to the relevant Italian Consulate/Embassy through the portal [Universitaly.it](https://www.universitaly.it) to apply for the visa for study reasons.

### Enrolment from 15 July to 31 October

To complete your enrolment at UniMC, register online and send the Student Administration Office of your Department:

- a copy, front and back, of your valid ID/passport
- for non-EU citizens, a copy of a valid residence permit or an application receipt for such permit
- all other required documents relative to your entry qualification.

# UniMC Tuition fees and Scholarships

## TUITION FEES

Article 34 of the Italian Constitution states that "capable and deserving students, including those lacking financial resources, have the right to access higher education". In accordance with this principle, UniMC provides that tuition fees constitute the least possible obstacle to accessing university studies for economically disadvantaged students. The maximum annual tuition fee for full-time enrolment in a bachelor's or master's degree programme is approximately € 1,600 per year. Yearly tuition fees are paid in 4 instalments:

- 1st instalment deadline: 31 October (€156 which covers a € 140 regional tax for the right to study and a € 16 tax stamp)
- 2nd instalment deadline: 31 January
- 3rd instalment deadline: 31 March
- 4th instalment deadline: 31 May.

## FEES REDUCTION

Regardless of nationality, all international students may apply for a reduction in the yearly tuition fees when enrolment and merit requirements are satisfied. The 2023/24 enrolment fees are as specified below:

- Students from an extremely poor and developing country: €156 per year
- Students from a non-OECD member country: € 156 per year
- Students from an OECD member country: € 611 per year.

## UNIMC SCHOLARSHIPS

UniMC offers scholarships to allow capable and deserving students to enrol.

In particular, 15 scholarships worth € 7,000.00 each for international students enrolling in a 3-year bachelor's degree course or in a 2-year master's degree course as well as scholarships for students enrolling in the first year of a bachelor's degree (3-year undergraduate) programme and scholarships for students enrolling in the first year of a master's degree.

## ON-CAMPUS JOBS

Part-time on-campus jobs are paid opportunities that UniMC offers all students. Selected students are engaged in a range of activities providing support to the university offices and services. Students can apply for merit-based on-campus jobs (senior tutoring and part-time collaborations) every year.

## INVEST YOUR TALENT IN ITALY SCHOLARSHIPS

UniMC is a partner of the Invest Your Talent in Italy (IYT) programme, which offers students from Azerbaijan, Armenia, Brazil, Colombia, Egypt, Ethiopia, Ghana, India, Indonesia, Iran, Kazakhstan, Mexico, People's Republic of China, Republic of Korea, Tunisia, Turkey and Vietnam the opportunity to attend selected master's programmes taught in English. The IYT programme is promoted by the Italian Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation - Directorate General for Public and Cultural Diplomacy, the Ministry of University and Research, ITA - Italian Trade Agency, and Uni-Italia, and combines university lectures with practical on-the-job training with an Italian company. The call for applications is launched yearly.

## GRANTS FOR FOREIGN AND ITALIAN CITIZENS LIVING ABROAD AWARDED BY THE ITALIAN GOVERNMENT (MAECI SCHOLARSHIP)

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation (MAECI) offers grants in favour of foreign citizens and Italian citizens living abroad (IRE) for the 2023/24 academic year in order to foster international cooperation in cultural, scientific and technological fields, to promote the Italian language and culture and to support the Italian economic system in the world. Grants are offered to complete study courses and research/training programs in public or legally recognized Italian educational institutions. Scholarships are available for those wishing to enrol in academic courses taught on the Italian territory only.
